This Module 3 based event promises to refresh and advance thinking on the issues of human behaviour.

This session has been designed for a knowledgeable, experienced audience concerned about the tricky interface between their board and its management team.

- Peter Stephenson, (PhD psychologist and consultant to boards), will open the afternoon with an overview to remind us of the theoretical underpinnings and key features of group dynamics
- New Brooms – a two-part case study, written for this session by Don Hathaway (governance expert and author), will present tough problems for individuals - and the whole board
- An exchange of insights will be facilitated “real time” using the innovative ‘Resolver’ technology, which allows feedback from small groups and the entire room
- Further exchange to extract the key lessons from the exercise will be facilitated in plenary session by Shauneen Bruder
- Courtney Pratt will summarise the afternoon and what we learned drawing on his experiences in some of the toughest board dynamics.

The emphasis throughout will be on the human element and how it challenges directors in their roles.
