ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for either scholarship, the scholarship applicant must currently serve as a board member or executive director of a not-for-profit organization in Canada or be newly appointed to such an organization. Scholarship decisions are based on the evidence provided of the financial need of the organization and the scholarship applicant, and on the anticipated benefits to the organization of the scholarship applicant's participation in the Program. Preference will be given to scholarship applicants from small not-for-profit organizations that have wide reach and impact, and that have demonstrated a commitment to good governance.
